

Burglary and Theft

Prevention Advice



Put yourself in a burglar's shoes. If you think like them then you can identify security risks around your home. The following tips can minimise opportunities:

- Lock and secure your doors and windows, including your sheds and garages.
- Photograph and record the make, model, and serial numbers of valuables.
- Consider engraving your tools and bicycles with your driver's license number.
- Consider installing sensor lights.
- Keep hedges and plants well trimmed - do not give burglars a place to hide.
- Check and maintain damaged fencing and locks.
- Note down and report car registrations and descriptions of suspicious vehicles or persons - burglars often scope a place out in advance.
