Well school holidays start this week so make sure that you have all the necessary equipment for the children if you are baby sitting grandchildren, such as the proper size seats and seatbelts in the car.

There have been so many house fires reported lately so here are some of the things you should do .

- Have a working smoke alarm and check that it is working regularly.
- Keep anything at least one metre away from a fire or heater as anything closer could catch fire.
- Be careful with any ash from the fire it should be emptied into a metal bucket and left outside on a fireproof area to cool down . It takes about 3 days for the ashes to go out completely.
- Open fires should be screened with a proper fireguard and never left unattended.
- Never sleep with an electric blanket on as this causes hot spots and that the cords and controls are not twisted or caught between the mattress and the bed. Twisted and worn cords are the biggest cause of electric blanket fires.
- Turn off all appliances when they are not in use. **Saves power also.**
